



## ***Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Remove-AzApplicationGatewaySslPolicy'***

***PS:\>Get-HELP Remove-AzApplicationGatewaySslPolicy -Full***

- Example 1: Remove an SSL policy from an application gateway -

```
$AppGW = Get-AzApplicationGateway -Name "ApplicationGateway01" -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01"
```

```
$AppGW = Remove-AzApplicationGatewaySslPolicy -ApplicationGateway $AppGW
```

```
Set-AzApplicationGateway -ApplicationGateway $AppGW
```

The first command gets the application gateway named ApplicationGateway01 in the resource group named ResourceGroup01 and stores it in the \$AppGW variable. The

second command removes the SSL policy from the application gateway. The last command updates the application gateway.
