



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Remove-AzBastion'

PS:\>Get-HELP Remove-AzBastion -Full

DESCRIPTION

Removes a bastion resource. Example1 deletes the bastion using its ResourceGroupName and ResourceName.

Example2 deletes the bastion using its object with pipeline.

Example3 deletes the bastion using its object.

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

```
Get-AzBastion -ResourceGroupName "BastionPowershellTest" -Name "testBastion" | Remove-AzBastion
```

----- Example 3 -----

```
$bastion = Get-AzBastion -ResourceGroupName "BastionPowershellTest" -Name "testBastion"  
Remove-AzBastion -InputObject $bastion
```
