---- Example 1: Delete an application from a Batch account ----

```
Remove-AzBatchApplication -AccountName "ContosoBatch" -ResourceGroupName "ContosoBatchGroup"  
-ApplicationName "Litware"
```

This command deletes the Litware application from the ContosoBatch account. The command fails if the application contains any packages.
