PS:\>Get-HELP Remove-AzDataLakeStoreAccount -Full

SYNOPSIS

Deletes a Data Lake Store account permanently.

DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzDataLakeStoreAccount cmdlet deletes a Data Lake Store account permanently.

The credentials, account, tenant, and subscription used for communication with azure

Specifies the resource group that contains the account to remove.

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

This cmdlet supports the common parameters: Verbose, Debug, ErrorAction, ErrorVariable, WarningAction, WarningVariable,

----- Example 1: Remove a Data Lake Store account -----

```
Remove-AzDataLakeStoreAccount -Name "ContosoADL"
```

This command removes the account named ContosoADL from the Data Lake Store.
