#### **SYNOPSIS**

Removes an integration account certificate from a resource group.

#### **SYNTAX**

```
Remove-AzIntegrationAccountCertificate -CertificateName <System.String> [-DefaultProfile  
    <Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>] [-Force] -Name  
    <System.String> -ResourceGroupName <System.String>  
    [-Confirm] [-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]
```

#### **DESCRIPTION**

The Remove-AzIntegrationAccountCertificate cmdlet removes an integration account certificate from a resource group. Specify the integration account name, resource group name, and certificate name. This module supports dynamic parameters. To use a dynamic parameter, type it in the command. To discover the names of dynamic parameters, type a hyphen (-) after the cmdlet name, and then press the Tab key repeatedly to cycle through the

available parameters. If you omit a required template parameter, the cmdlet prompts you for the value.

```
Remove-AzIntegrationAccountCertificate -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup11" -Name "IntegrationAccount31"  
-CertificateName "IntegrationAccountCertificate01"
```

This command removes the integration account certificate named IntegrationAccount31.
