Removes a media service.

DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzMediaService cmdlet removes a media service.

-AccountName <System.String>

Specifies the name of the media service that this cmdlet removes.

Specifies the name of the resource group that contains the media service.

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

-WhatIf <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

----- Example 1: Remove a media service -----

```
Remove-AzMediaService -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup001" -AccountName "MediaService0011"
```

This command removes the media service named MediaService0011 in the resource group named ResourceGroup001.
