



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Remove-AzNetworkProfile'

PS:|>Get-HELP Remove-AzNetworkProfile -Full

DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzNetworkProfile cmdlet removes a network profile if no container network interfaces (as contrasted to a container network interface configuration) have been created.

Remove-AzNetworkProfile -Name np1 -ResourceGroupName rg1

This removes the network profile with name np1 from the resource group rg1.
