Remove-AzResourceGroupDeployment

SYNOPSIS

Removes a resource group deployment and any associated operations.

SYNTAX

Remove-AzResourceGroupDeployment [-DefaultProfile
<Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>] -Id <System.String>
[-Pre] [-Confirm] [-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]

DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzResourceGroupDeployment cmdlet removes an Azure resource group deployment and any associated

operations.

The credentials, account, tenant, and subscription used for communication with azure

Specifies the ID of the resource group deployment to remove.

Indicates that this cmdlet considers pre-release API versions when it automatically determines which version to use.

Specifies the name of the resource group to remove.

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

-WhatIf <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

Example 1: Removes a resource group deployment with ResourceId

```
Remove-AzResourceGroupDeployment -ResourceId
```

```
/subscriptions/xxxxxxxx-xxxx-xxxx-xxxx-xxxxxxxxxxxx/resourceGroups/testGroup/providers/Microsoft.Resources/deployments/testDeployment1
```

True

This command removes a resource group deployment with the fully qualified resource Id of the deployment. Successful removal returns true.

Example 2: Removes a resource group deployment with ResourceGroupName and ResourceName

```
Remove-AzResourceGroupDeployment -ResourceGroupName testGroup -Name testDeployment1
```

True

This command removes a resource group deployment with the provided ResourceGroupName and ResourceName. Successful removal returns true.
