SYNOPSIS

Deletes a custom role in Azure RBAC. The role to be deleted is specified using the Id property of the role. Delete will fail if there are existing role assignments made to the custom role.

that custom role. By default, Remove-AzRoleDefinition prompts you for confirmation. To suppress the prompt, use the Force parameter. If there are existing role

assignments made to the custom role to be deleted, the delete will fail.
