



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Remove-AzRouteFilter'

PS:\>Get-HELP Remove-AzRouteFilter -Full

Remove-AzRouteFilter -Name "RouteFilter01" -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01"
```

The command removes the route filter named RouteFilter01 in the resource group named ResourceGroup01.
