----- Example 1: Removes a job step from a job -----

```
$jobStep = Get-AzSqlElasticJobStep -ResourceGroupName rg -ServerName elasticjobserver -AgentName agent  
-JobName job1 -Name step1  
$jobStep | Remove-AzSqlElasticJobStep
```

```
JobName StepName StepId TargetGroupName CredentialName Output CommandText
```

```
-----  
job1 step1 1 tg1 cred1 SELECT 1
```

Removes a job step from a job

----- Example 2 -----

```
Remove-AzSqlElasticJobStep -AgentName agent -JobName job1 -Name step1 -ResourceGroupName  
MyResourceGroup -ServerName s1
```
