DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzSqlInstancePool cmdlet removes an Azure SQL Instance pool.

----- Example 1: Remove an instance pool -----

Remove-AzSqlInstancePool -ResourceGroupName resourcegroup01 -Name instancePool0

Example 2: Remove an instance pool by its resource identifier

```
Remove-AzSqlInstancePool -ResourceId
```

```
"/subscriptions/xxxxxxx-xxxx-xxxx-xxxx-xxxxxxxxxxxx/resourceGroups/resourcegroup01/providers/Microsoft.Sql/instancePools/instancePool0"
```

Example 3: Remove an instance pool by an instance pool object

```
Get-AzSqlInstancePool -ResourceGroupName resourcegroup01 -Name instancePool0
```

```
Remove-AzSqlInstancePool -InputObject $instancePool
```

This command removes an instance pool named instancePool0.
