Removes an Azure SQL Database Sync Group.

The Remove-AzSqlSyncGroup cmdlet removes an Azure SQL Database Sync Group.

----- Example 1: Remove a sync group -----

```
Remove-AzSqlSyncGroup -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01" -ServerName "Server01" -DatabaseName  
"database01" -Name "syncGroup01"
```

This command removes the Azure SQL Database Sync Group named syncGroup01.
