Removes a sql script from a Synapse workspace.

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

```
Remove-AzSynapseSqlScript -WorkspaceName ContosoWorkspace -Name ContosoSqlScript
```

Remove a sql script called ContosoSqlScript from the workspace ContosoWorkspace.

----- Example 2 -----

```
$ws = Get-AzSynapseWorkspace -Name ContosoWorkspace
```

```
$ws | Remove-AzSynapseSqlScript -Name ContosoSqlScript
```

Remove a sql script called ContosoSqlScript from the workspace ContosoWorkspace through pipeline.

----- Example 3 -----

```
$sqlscript = Get-AzSynapseSqlScript -WorkspaceName ContosoWorkspace -Name ContosoSqlScript
```

```
$sqlscript | Remove-AzSynapseSqlScript
```

Remove a sql script called ContosoSqlScript from the workspace ContosoWorkspace through pipeline.
