SYNOPSIS

Removes a custom script extension from a virtual machine.

DESCRIPTION

The Remove-AzVMCustomScriptExtension cmdlet removes a custom script Virtual Machine Extension from a virtual machine.

The credentials, account, tenant, and subscription used for communication with azure.

Forces the command to run without asking for user confirmation.

Starts the operation and returns immediately, before the operation is completed. In order to determine if the operation has successfully been completed, use some other mechanism.

-ResourceGroupName <System.String>

Specifies the name of the resource group of the virtual machine.

Specifies the name of a virtual machine from which this cmdlet removes the custom script extension.

Required? true

-Confirm <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

-WhatIf <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.
