



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Reset-AppSharedPackageContainer'

PS:\>Get-HELP Reset-AppSharedPackageContainer -Full

NAME

Reset-AppSharedPackageContainer

SYNOPSIS

Destroys all the application data of the container.

SYNTAX

Reset-AppSharedPackageContainer [-Name] <String> [-Force] [-Confirm] [-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]

DESCRIPTION

The cmdlet destroys all the application data of the container, including the virtual files and registry keys.

PARAMETERS

-Force <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Skips asking for confirmation.

-Name <String>

The name of the container.

-Confirm <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Prompts you for confirmation before running the cmdlet.

-WhatIf <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet isn't run.
