### ----- Example 1 -----

```
$gw = Get-AzApplicationGateway -Name $appgwName -ResourceGroupName $resgpName  
$gw = Set-AzApplicationGatewayAutoscaleConfiguration -ApplicationGateway $gw -MinCapacity 5  
$gw = Set-AzApplicationGateway -ApplicationGateway $gw
```

The first command gets the application gateway and stores it in \$gw variable. The second command updates the autoscale configuration from the application gateway. The third command updates the application gateway on Azure.

### ----- Example 2 -----

```
Set-AzApplicationGatewayAutoscaleConfiguration -ApplicationGateway <PSApplicationGateway> -MaxCapacity 5  
-MinCapacity 4
```
