----- Example 1: Update a routing rule -----

```
$AppGw = Get-AzApplicationGateway -Name "ApplicationGateway01" -ResourceGroupName "ResourceGroup01"  
$AppGw = Set-AzApplicationGatewayRoutingRule -ApplicationGateway $AppGw -Name "Rule01" -RuleType Basic  
-Priority 100 -BackendSettings $Setting -Listener $Listener  
-BackendAddressPool $Pool
```

The first command gets the application gateway named ApplicationGateway01 and stores it in the \$AppGw variable. The second command modifies the routing rule for the

application gateway to use back-end settings specified in the \$Setting variable, a listener specified in the \$Listener variable, and a back-end address pool specified in the \$Pool variable.
