Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

Set-AzSynapseDataset -WorkspaceName ContosoWorkspace -Name ContosoDataset -DefinitionFile  
"C:\samples\Dataset.json"
```

This command creates a dataset named ContosoDataset in the workspace named ContosoWorkspace. The command bases the dataset on information in the Dataset.json file.
