----- Example 1 -----

```
Set-AzWebAppSlotConfigName -ResourceGroupName "Default-Web-WestUS" -Name "ContosoWebApp"  
-RemoveAllAppSettingNames -RemoveAllConnectionStringNames
```

This command removes all app settings and connection strings for Web App ContosoWebApp associated with the resource group Default-Web-WestUS

----- Example 2 -----

```
Set-AzWebAppSlotConfigName -AppSettingNames <String[]> -Name 'ContosoWebApp' -ResourceGroupName  
'Default-Web-WestUS'
```
