



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Stop-Transcript'

PS:\>Get-HELP Stop-Transcript -Full

NAME

Stop-Transcript

SYNOPSIS

Stops a transcript.

SYNTAX

Stop-Transcript [<CommonParameters>]

DESCRIPTION

The `Stop-Transcript` cmdlet stops a transcript that was started by the `Start-Transcript` cmdlet. Alternatively, you can end a session to stop a transcript.

PARAMETERS

<CommonParameters>

This cmdlet supports the common parameters: Verbose, Debug,
ErrorAction, ErrorVariable, WarningAction, WarningVariable,

INPUTS

None

You can't pipe objects to this cmdlet.

OUTPUTS

System.String

This cmdlet returns a string that contains a status message and the path to the output file.

NOTES

If a transcript hasn't been started, the command fails.

----- Example 1: Stop all transcripts -----

Stop-Transcript

This command stops all transcripts.
