



Windows PowerShell Get-Help on Cmdlet 'Undo-DtcDiagnosticTransaction'

PS:\>Get-HELP Undo-DtcDiagnosticTransaction -Full

NAME

Undo-DtcDiagnosticTransaction

SYNOPSIS

Invokes the Abort process on the specified transaction.

SYNTAX

Undo-DtcDiagnosticTransaction [-Transaction] <DtcDiagnosticTransaction> [<CommonParameters>]

DESCRIPTION

The Undo-DtcDiagnosticTransaction cmdlet invokes the Abort process on the specified transaction.

PARAMETERS

-Transaction <DtcDiagnosticTransaction>

Specifies the DtcDiagnosticTransaction object on which to invoke the Abort process. You can use the pipeline operator to pass this parameter value to the cmdlet.

----- Example 1: Undo a DTC diagnostic transaction -----

```
PS C:\> $Tx = New-DtcDiagnosticTransaction
```

```
PS C:\> Undo-DtcDiagnosticTransaction -Transaction $Tx
```

This command creates a new diagnostic transaction and assigns it to a variable.

The second command undoes the transaction.
