Unregister-AzProviderPreviewFeature

SYNOPSIS

Removes a feature registration from your account.

SYNTAX

```
Unregister-AzProviderPreviewFeature [-DefaultProfile  
<Microsoft.Azure.Commands.Common.Authentication.Abstractions.Core.IAzureContextContainer>] -Name <System.String>  
  
[-PassThru] -ProviderNamespace <System.String> [-Confirm] [-WhatIf] [<CommonParameters>]
```

DESCRIPTION

The Unregister-AzProviderPreviewFeature cmdlet removes a feature registration from your account.

The credentials, account, tenant, and subscription used for communication with Azure.

-WhatIf <System.Management.Automation.SwitchParameter>

Shows what would happen if the cmdlet runs. The cmdlet is not run.

----- Example 1: Removes a feature registration -----

```
Unregister-AzProviderPreviewFeature -FeatureName AllowApplicationSecurityGroups -ProviderNamespace  
Microsoft.Network
```

This removes the AllowApplicationSecurityGroups feature for Microsoft.Network from your account.
