SYNOPSIS

Updates 'tags' and 'enabled' fields in an existing Alert rule.

This method is used to update the Alert rule tags, and to enable or disable the Alert rule.

To update other fields use CreateOrUpdate operation.

COMPLEX PARAMETER PROPERTIES

To create the parameters described below, construct a hash table containing the appropriate properties. For information on hash tables, run Get-Help

about_Hash_Tables.

INPUTOBJECT <IActivityLogAlertIdentity>: Identity Parameter

[ActivityLogAlertName <String>]: The name of the Activity Log Alert rule.

[Id <String>]: Resource identity path

[ResourceGroupName <String>]: The name of the resource group. The name is case insensitive.

[SubscriptionId <String>]: The ID of the target subscription.

----- EXAMPLE 1 -----

```
PS C:\>Update-AzActivityLogAlert -ResourceGroupName $ResourceGroupName -Name $AlertName -Tag
@{"key"="val"} -Enabled $false
```
