### COMPLEX PARAMETER PROPERTIES

To create the parameters described below, construct a hash table containing the appropriate properties. For information on hash tables, run Get-Help

about\_Hash\_Tables.



HEALTHPROBESETTING <IHealthProbeParameters>: Health probe settings to the origin that is used to determine the health of the origin.

[ProbeIntervalInSecond <Int32?>]: The number of seconds between health probes. Default is 240sec.

[ProbePath <String>]: The path relative to the origin that is used to determine the health of the origin.

[ProbeProtocol <ProbeProtocol?>]: Protocol to use for health probe.

[ProbeRequestType <HealthProbeRequestType?>]: The type of health probe request that is made.

INPUTOBJECT <ICdnIdentity>: Identity Parameter

[CustomDomainName <String>]: Name of the domain under the profile which is unique globally.

[EndpointName <String>]: Name of the endpoint under the profile which is unique globally.

[Id <String>]: Resource identity path

[OriginGroupName <String>]: Name of the origin group which is unique within the endpoint.

[OriginName <String>]: Name of the origin which is unique within the profile.

[ProfileName <String>]: Name of the Azure Front Door Standard or Azure Front Door Premium which is unique within the resource group.

[ResourceGroupName <String>]: Name of the Resource group within the Azure subscription.

[RouteName <String>]: Name of the routing rule.

[RuleName <String>]: Name of the delivery rule which is unique within the endpoint.

[RuleSetName <String>]: Name of the rule set under the profile which is unique globally.

[SecretName <String>]: Name of the Secret under the profile.

[SecurityPolicyName <String>]: Name of the security policy under the profile.

[SubscriptionId <String>]: Azure Subscription ID.

ORIGIN <IResourceReference[]>: The source of the content being delivered via CDN within given origin group.

[Id <String>]: Resource ID.

RESPONSEBASEDORIGINERRORDETECTIONSETTING <IResponseBasedOriginErrorDetectionParameters>: The JSON object that contains the properties to determine origin health

using real requests/responses. This property is currently not supported.

[HttpErrorRange <IHttpErrorRangeParameters[]>]: The list of Http status code ranges that are considered as server errors for origin and it is marked as

unhealthy.

[Begin <Int32?>]: The inclusive start of the http status code range.

[End <Int32?>]: The inclusive end of the http status code range.

[ResponseBasedDetectedErrorType <ResponseBasedDetectedErrorTypes?>]: Type of response errors for real user requests for which origin will be deemed unhealthy

[ResponseBasedFailoverThresholdPercentage <Int32?>]: The percentage of failed requests in the sample where failover should trigger.
