### NAME

austlog - a program similar to lastlog

### SYNOPSIS

austlog [ options ]

### DESCRIPTION

austlog is a program that prints out the last login for all users of the local machine similar to the way lastlog does. The login-name, port, and last login time will be printed.

If the user has never logged in, the message **\*\* Never logged in\*\*** will be displayed instead of the port and time.

### OPTIONS

-u, --user

Print the lastlog record for user with specified LOGIN only.

--stdin

Use stdin as the source of audit records. The audit events must be in the raw format.
