buildah-source-push(1) General Commands Manual buildah-source-push(1)

NAME

buildah-source-push - Push a source image from a specified path to a registry.

SYNOPSIS

buildah source push [options] path registry

DESCRIPTION

Push a source image from a specified path to a registry.

Note that the buildah-source command and all its subcommands are experimental and may be subject to future changes.

OPTIONS

--creds creds

The [username[:password]] to use to authenticate with the registry if required. If one or both values are not supplied, a command line prompt will appear and the value can be entered. The password is entered without echo.

--quiet, -q

Suppress the progress output when pushing a source image.

--tls-verify bool-value

Require HTTPS and verification of certificates when talking to container registries (defaults to true). TLS verification cannot be used when talking to an insecure registry.
