DESCRIPTION

These functions calculate the complex hyperbolic tangent of z .

The complex hyperbolic tangent function is defined mathematically as:

$$\operatorname{ctanh}(z) = \operatorname{csinh}(z) / \operatorname{ccosh}(z)$$

VERSIONS

These functions first appeared in glibc in version 2.1.
