Description

foomatic-addpjloptions formats the PJL information file (or STDIN) into a format usable by the Foomatic database.

Options

- -a Convert all PJL options in the information file.
- -d Enable debugging information.
- -f Do not ask for permission, force conversion.
- -h Print a help message and exit.
- -q Print a summary of the PJL information. This output is not com? patible with the foomatic database, and is useful for debugging.
- -s Produce a single option file containing all the option values.
- -o dir

The directory the option information files are written to.

-p printer_ID

tract printer manufacturer and model information.

pjl_info_file

File with PJL information returned by the printer. If this file?

name is not provided, the PJL options are taken from standard in?
