#### **DESCRIPTION**

mq\_close() closes the message queue descriptor mqdes.

If the calling process has attached a notification request (see (mq\_no?

tify(3)) to this message queue via mqdes, then this request is removed,

and another process can now attach a notification request.

#### **RETURN VALUE**

On success mq\_close() returns 0; on error, -1 is returned, with errno set to indicate the error.

EBADF The message queue descriptor specified in mqdes is invalid.
