podman-manifest-exists(1) General Commands Manual podman-manifest-exists(1)

NAME

podman-manifest-exists - Check if the given manifest list exists in local storage

SYNOPSIS

podman manifest exists manifest

DESCRIPTION

podman manifest exists checks if a manifest list exists on local storage. Podman will return an exit code of 0 when the manifest is found. A non-zero exit code will be returned otherwise. An exit code of 125 indicates there was another issue.

OPTIONS

--help, -h

Print usage statement.

EXAMPLE

Check if a manifest list called list1 exists (the manifest list does actually exist).

```
$ podman manifest exists list1
```

```
$ echo $?
```

```
0
```

```
$
```

Check if a manifest called mylist exists (the manifest list does not actually exist).

```
$ podman manifest exists mylist
```

```
$ echo $?
```

```
1
```

```
$
```
