xisxwayland - tool to be used within shell scripts to check for Xway?  
land

#### SYNOPSIS

xisxwayland [-v|--verbose]

#### DESCRIPTION

Connects to the X server using the \$DISPLAY environment variable and  
checks whether that server is an Xwayland server.

#### OPTIONS

--verbose, -v  
Print to stdout whether the X server is an Xwayland server or  
not

#### EXIT STATUS

xisxwayland exits with status 0 if the X server is Xwayland or 1 other?  
wise. Where an error is encountered, xisxwayland exits with status 3.
