zipnote(1)

NAME

zipsplit - split a zipfile into smaller zipfiles

SYNOPSIS

zipsplit [-t] [-i] [-p] [-s] [-n size] [-r room] [-b path] [-h] [-q]

[-v] [-L] zipfile

ARGUMENTS

zipfile Zipfile to split.

OPTIONS

- -t Report how many files it will take, but don't make them.
- Make index (zipsplit.idx) and count its size against first zip file.
- -n size

Make zip files no larger than "size" (default = 36000).

-r room

Leave room for "room" bytes on the first disk (default = 0).

-b path

Use path for the output zip files.

- p Pause between output zip files.
- -s Do a sequential split even if it takes more zip files.
- -h Show a short help.
- -q Suppress some informational messages.
- -v Show version information.

-L Show software license.

DESCRIPTION

zipsplit reads a zipfile and splits it into smaller zipfiles.
