**\$ man chcat.8**

CHCAT(8) User Commands CHCAT(8)

#### NAME

chcat - change file SELinux security category

#### SYNOPSIS

chcat category file...

chcat -l category user...

chcat [[+|-]category...] file...

chcat -l [[+|-]category...] user...

chcat [-d] file...

chcat -l [-d] user...

chcat -L [-l] [ user ... ]

#### DESCRIPTION

Change/Remove the security category for each file or user.

Use +/- to add/remove categories from a file or user.

Note: When removing a category you must specify '--' on the command line before using the -Category syntax. This tells the command that you have finished entering options and are now specifying a category name instead.

- d delete the category from each FILE/USER.
- L list available categories.
- I Tells chcat to operate on users instead of files.
