NAME

e2label - Change the label on an ext2/ext3/ext4 file system

SYNOPSIS

e2label device [volume-label]

DESCRIPTION

e2label will display or change the volume label on the ext2, ext3, or ext4 file system located on device.

If the optional argument volume-label is not present, e2label will simply display the current volume label.

If the optional argument volume-label is present, then e2label will set the volume label to be volume-label. Ext2 volume labels can be at most 16 characters long; if volume-label is longer than 16 characters, e2la?

bel will truncate it and print a warning message.

It is also possible to set the volume label using the `-L` option of `tune2fs(8)`.
