\$ man era_check.8

era_check(8) System Manager's Manual era_check(8)

NAME

era_check - validate era metadata on device or file.

SYNOPSIS

era_check [options] {device|file}

DESCRIPTION

era_check checks era metadata created by the device-mapper era target on a device or file.

This tool cannot be run on live metadata.

OPTIONS

-h, --help

Print help and exit.

`-V, --version`

Print version information and exit.

`-q, --quiet`

Suppress output messages, return only exit code.

`--super-block-only`

Only check the superblock is present.

EXAMPLE

Analyse thin provisioning metadata on logical volume `/dev/vg/metadata`:

```
$ era_check /dev/vg/metadata
```

The device may not be actively used by the target when running.

DIAGNOSTICS

`era_check` returns an exit code of 0 for success or 1 for error.
