eutp lets you exchange files with a Clio terminal from EuroBraille.

SHELL EXPANSIONS

Beware of special chars: \* and . are often expanded by your shell, hence sending files \* will probably do what you want, putting every file existing in the current directory onto the terminal, but receiving files \* may not do what you want: it will only get every file which already exist in the current directory, skipping those you just created on your terminal ! If you want to get every file which exist in the

terminal, you should use '\*' or something similar (please read your shell manual).

The same warning applies to other special chars, such as \$, ~, &,... which should be protected by surrounding arguments by quotes (') or by using single backslashes (\) just before them (please read your shell manual).
