DESCRIPTION

This function returns the current file creation mask. It is equivalent

```
to
  mode_t getumask(void)
  {
    mode_t mask = umask( 0 );
    umask(mask);
    return mask;
  }
```

with the umask(2) library call).

CONFORMING TO

This is a vaporware GNU extension.

NOTES

This function is documented in the glibc manual, but, as at glibc ver? sion 2.24, it is not implemented on Linux. (See umask(2) for a thread-safe method of discovering a process's umask.)
