#### NAME

grub-mknetdir - prepare a GRUB netboot directory.

#### SYNOPSIS

grub-mknetdir [OPTION...]

#### DESCRIPTION

Prepares GRUB network boot images at net\_directory/subdir assuming net\_directory being TFTP root.

--appended-signature-size=SIZE

Add a note segment reserving SIZE bytes for an appended signature

--compress=no|xz|gz|lzo

compress GRUB files [optional]

--disable-shim-lock

disable shim\_lock verifier

--dtb=FILE

embed a specific DTB

-d, --directory=DIR

use images and modules under DIR [default=/usr/lib/grub/<platform>]  
form>]

--fonts=FONTSDescription: install FONTSDescription: [default=unicode]

--install-modules=MODULESDescription: install only MODULES and their dependencies [default=all]

-k, --pubkey=FILEDescription: embed FILE as public key for signature checking

--locale-directory=DIRDescription: use translations under DIRDescription: [default=/usr/share/locale]

--locales=LOCALESDescription: install only LOCALES [default=all]

--modules=MODULESDescription: pre-load specified modules MODULES

--sbat=FILEDescription: SBAT metadata

--themes=THEMESDescription: install THEMES [default=starfield]

-v, --verboseDescription: print verbose messages.

-x, --x509key=FILEDescription: embed FILE as an x509 certificate for signature checking

--core-compress=xz|none|autoDescription: choose the compression to use for core image

--net-directory=DIRDescription: root directory of TFTP server

--subdir=DIRDescription: relative subdirectory on network server

-, --helpDescription: give this help list

--usageDescription: give a short usage message

-V, --version

print program version

Mandatory or optional arguments to long options are also mandatory or optional for any corresponding short options.

Prepares GRUB network boot images at `net_directory/subdir` assuming `net_directory` being TFTP root.
