NAME

nvme-seagate-vs-pcie-stats - Retrieve Seagate vendor specific PCIe
error statistics

SYNOPSIS

nvme seagate vs-pcie-stats <device> [OPTIONS]

DESCRIPTION

This command will only work on Seagate devices supporting this feature.

Not all commands work across all product families.

The <device> parameter is mandatory and it may be either an NVMe

character device (ex: /dev/nvme0) or an nvme block device (ex:

/dev/nvme0n1).

OPTIONS

-o <FMT>, --output-format=<FMT>

Output in binary format

EXAMPLES

Get the vendor specific PCIe error statistics for the specified device.

nvme seagate vs-pcie-stats /dev/nvme0
