\$ man xdg-user-dir.1

XDG-USER-DIR(1) User Commands XDG-USER-DIR(1)

NAME

xdg-user-dir - Find an XDG user dir

SYNOPSIS

xdg-user-dir [NAME]

DESCRIPTION

xdg-user-dir looks up the current path for one of the special XDG user dirs.

This command expects the name of an XDG user dir as argument. The possible names are:

DESKTOP

DOWNLOAD

TEMPLATES

PUBLICSHARE

DOCUMENTS

MUSIC

PICTURES

VIDEOS

FILES

The values are looked up in the `user-dirs.dir` file. This file is created by the `xdg-user-dirs-update` utility.

ENVIRONMENT

The `XDG_CONFIG_HOME` environment variable determines where the `user-dirs.dirs` file is located.
