NAME

xfs rtcp - XFS realtime copy command

#### **SYNOPSIS**

xfs\_rtcp [ -e extsize ] [ -p ] source ... target

xfs\_rtcp -V

#### **DESCRIPTION**

xfs\_rtcp copies a file to the realtime partition on an XFS filesystem.

If there is more than one source and target, the final argument (the target) must be a directory which already exists.

# **OPTIONS**

-e extsize

Sets the extent size of the destination realtime file.

-p Use if the size of the source file is not an even multiple of the block size of the destination filesystem. When -p is speci? fied xfs\_rtcp will pad the destination file to a size which is an even multiple of the filesystem block size. This is neces? sary since the realtime file is created using direct I/O and the

minimum I/O is the filesystem block size.

-V Prints the version number and exits.
