Error::TypeTiny::WrongNumberOfParameters – exception for Type::Params

## STATUS

## DESCRIPTION

Thrown when a Type::Params compiled check is called with the wrong number of parameters.

This package inherits from Error::TypeTiny; see that for most documentation. Major differences are listed below:

### Attributes

minimum

The minimum expected number of parameters.

maximum

The maximum expected number of parameters.

got

The number of parameters actually passed to the compiled check.

### Methods

has\_minimum, has\_maximum

Predicate methods.
