**SYNOPSIS**

use File::HomeDir;

# Find directories for the current user
$home      = File::HomeDir->my_home;      # /home/mylogin
$desktop   = File::HomeDir->my_desktop;    # All of these will...
$docs      = File::HomeDir->my_documents;  # ...default to home...
$music     = File::HomeDir->my_music;      # ...directory
$pics      = File::HomeDir->my_pictures;   #
$videos    = File::HomeDir->my_videos;     #
$data      = File::HomeDir->my_data;       #
```

**DESCRIPTION**

This module provides implementations for determining common user directories. In normal usage this module will always be used via File::HomeDir.
