NAME

basename - Print NAME with any leading directory components removed. If specified, also remove a trailing SUFFIX.

SYNOPSIS

basename [-a|--multiple] [-s|--suffix] [-z|--zero] [-h|--help] [-V|--version] [name]

DESCRIPTION

Print NAME with any leading directory components removed. If specified, also remove a trailing SUFFIX.

OPTIONS

-a, --multiple
support multiple arguments and treat each as a NAME

-s, --suffix <SUFFIX>
remove a trailing SUFFIX; implies -a

-z, --zero
end each output line with NUL, not newline

-h, --help
Print help

-V, --version
Print version
