C99(1) General Commands Manual C99(1)

NAME

c99 - ANSI (1999) C compiler

SYNOPSIS

c99 [-pedantic] [-pedantic-errors] [-D_ANSI_SOURCE] options ...

DESCRIPTION

Calls the C compiler (cc) with the given options , using a C language environment compatible with the -ansiC specification.

This includes proper handling of trigraphs, disabling non-ANSI compiler features (such as asm, inline, typeof, and the \$ character in identifiers), and definition of the preprocessor symbol `__STRICT_ANSI__` .

HISTORY

Appeared in NetBSD 1.4 .

BUGS

Since c99 is a shell wrapper script to cc , compile errors are prefixed by "cc:".

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
