    c = cacos(z);

    printf("cacos() = %6.3f %6.3fi\n", creal(c), cimag(c));

    f = -i * clog(z + i * csqrt(1 - z * z));

    printf("formula = %6.3f %6.3fi\n", creal(f), cimag(f));
