NAME

csplit - Split a file into sections determined by context lines

SYNOPSIS

csplit [-b|--suffix-format] [-f|--prefix] [-k|--keep-files] [--suppress-matched] [-n|--dig?
its] [-q|--quiet] [-z|--elide-empty-files] [-h|--help] [-V|--version] <file> <pattern>

DESCRIPTION

Split a file into sections determined by context lines

OPTIONS

-b, --suffix-format <FORMAT>

use sprintf FORMAT instead of %02d

-f, --prefix <PREFIX>

use PREFIX instead of 'xx'

-k, --keep-files

do not remove output files on errors

--suppress-matched

suppress the lines matching PATTERN

-n, --digits <DIGITS>

use specified number of digits instead of 2

-q, --quiet

do not print counts of output file sizes

-z, --elide-empty-files

remove empty output files

-h, --help

Print help

-V, --version

Print version

EXTRA

Output pieces of FILE separated by PATTERN(s) to files 'xx00', 'xx01', ..., and output byte counts of each piece to standard output.

v(utils coreutils) 0.8.0

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
