dconf-service - D-Bus service for writes to the dconf database

SYNOPSIS

dconf-service

DESCRIPTION

The dconf-service program provides the ca.desrt.dconf name on the session or system bus.

Users or administrators should never need to start the service, as it will be automatically

started by `dbus-daemon(1)` whenever an application tries to write settings.

Reading values from the dconf database does not involve the service; it is only needed for

writes. The service is stateless and can exit freely at any time (and is therefore robust

against crashes).
