#### NAME

echo - Display a line of text

#### SYNOPSIS

echo [-n ] [-e ] [-E ] [-h|--help] [-V|--version] [STRING]

#### DESCRIPTION

Display a line of text

#### OPTIONS

- n    do not output the trailing newline
- e    enable interpretation of backslash escapes
- E    disable interpretation of backslash escapes (default)
- h, --help  
      Print help
- V, --version  
      Print version

[STRING]

#### EXTRA

Echo the STRING(s) to standard output.

If -e is in effect, the following sequences are recognized:

- \ backslash - \a alert (BEL) - \b backspace - \c produce no further output - \e escape -  
\f form feed - \n new line - \r carriage return - \t horizontal tab - \v vertical tab -  
\ONNN byte with octal value NNN (1 to 3 digits) - \xHH byte with hexadecimal value HH (1 to  
2 digits)
